- Decision Day--May 1,

- Complete loan counseling and sign your promissory note

To dos before you leave for College in August

- Make sure you know your new college email/user-id and passwords
- Check your college email daily for important updates and to-do's
- Be sure to schedule a college orientation session
- Complete all placement test before school begins ie.(Foreign Language/Math)
- Submit Medical Forms & Vaccination Records to Student Health Services
- Submit your Learning Disability documentation(if applicable)
 - ◆ Students who have been diagnosed with a learning disability or have received academic accommodations in the past should submit their psycho-educational evaluation to your college's Disability Services Office.
- Transfer any college or university coursework you may have received as a high school student to your chosen college.

Exams and Last day of Classes

- EXAMS - Students in danger of failing are required to complete a final assignment instead of an exam. Students in good standing (70 or above for the year) will not need to complete an exam.
- May 8th is the last day of classes for seniors

Credit Recovery

Students in need of credit recovery will be given the opportunity beginning June 1

- Students will be assigned classwork from their teacher and/or an APEX Learning module

End of the Year Calendar of Events
