# Further Details.....

**Final Assignments** – Instead of Final Exams, students that are achieving below a 70 for the year in a class will be required to complete a final assignment. Teachers will notify you via email by Friday May 15 if you are to complete this assignment. Final assignments will be due by May 22 at the latest.
